Fr Benjamin writes ...

During the week I was on a packed London Underground train, full of passengers who for the most part were engaged in their phones and ear pods and keeping very much to their own world. Then I spotted two people, with heads, bowed and lips silently moving. Betwixt the fingers of one was a Rosary. Now, I was fairly flustered when I boarded that train, due to the usual severe delays and contemplating having to board another connecting train without having time for a coffee. Seeing those two ladies praying calmed me immediately. It was as if in that crowded frenetic capsule of travellers a little porthole was open to the Divine – and indeed, it was so. Amidst the delays, googling, and podcasting, something of God's Kingdom was also present. Silently, I too began to pray, "Thy Kingdom come", not in order to catch my next train, but simply to be a part of the porthole of peace.

Today we celebrate, Christ the King of the Universe, contemplating Him as our Sovereign and Lord. If, however, He is a King – and more than that, the King of kings – then He must have a Kingdom. I believe I experienced a little glimmer of its glory on that fusty little train carriage. It is so easy to forget this Kingdom is open to us and in our midst, but it is also easy to enter into it and allow the Lord's Kingdom (another term for His Presence) to enter into us and to be with us.

To acknowledge Christ as King is to acknowledge this as being with us, as being the Emmanuel of the prophets whom we will hear in a few weeks' time. We, His people, can act as portholes of that Kingdom and kingly presence through prayer, charity and service. We can say to the likes of Pontius Pilate, who want to be kings, that to pray is to crown God, to serve is to reign and to bend the knee at the Name of Jesus is to find joy.
